#### **Bug Fixes**

Flash memory was corrupted during firmware downloads. This bug has been corrected in the current release.

#### **Notice to Users**

On rare occasions, the number of Errored Seconds/Unavailable Seconds (ES/UAS) counts in the 15 minute HDSL performance history will differ by 3 to 10 seconds through the Simple Network Management Protocol (SNMP) and Terminal Access Option (TAO) interfaces.

#### BACKWARD COMPATIBILITY AND UPGRADES

#### Compatibility with Previous Versions of HDSL Unit Firmware

EMU software Version 3.20.01 requires that the HDSL units use software Version 3.10 and later to ensure proper operation of the Robust Download Protocol.

#### **Compatibility with Previous Versions of SNMP Management Information Bases**

This version of EMU software (3.20.01) requires the current release of SNMP Managment Information Base (MIB) files to support Rate Selectable line units. A new MIB item has been added to support Nx64k port configuration and a new MIB table to show all line units in a shelf.

The MIB files for EMU software Version 3.20.01 are identified in the following list. The MIB files should be compiled in the order listed.

### **UPGRADE METHODS**

**From Version 1.1.** EMU-830 management units running software Version 1.1 must be upgraded by replacing the two PROM chips on the board. These chips may be ordered from PairGain as part of the EMU-830 Management Unit Software Upgrade Kit (part number 150-1491-01). This kit includes the following:

- EMU-830 Firmware Upgrade PROMs
- EMU-830 List 2 Technical Practice, 700-030-102-01
- SNMP MIB Diskette
- HDSL Unit Firmware Diskette

**From Version 2.xx or Later.** EMU-830 management units running software Version 2.xx or later may be upgraded either by replacing the PROM chips (described above) or by performing a firmware download using a maintenance terminal or PC with a terminal emulation program. The Version 3.20.01 image file (muv32001.img) can be downloaded from the Customer Site portion of PairGain's Web page at <a href="http://www.pairgain.com">http://www.pairgain.com</a>.
